
- 1. What are microaggressions? Include 2 examples.

- 4. Write 3 more sentences to share more information you found out from the video or to summarise its contents/your own thoughts/reflections about it.


## <u>Task 3:</u>


Unit 14 is about comparing and contrasting different physiological disorders. Below are examples of physiological disorders and the body system that they mainly effect.
