Some of them are retiring, others are moving onto new educational establishments, whilst others are sadly leaving the teaching profession. I know you will join me in expressing our sincere thanks for their hard work, dedication, and the positive influence they have had on our community during their time with us and wish them well on their next adventure. At the time of this letter, I can confirm we are fully staffed for September. As in previous years, we will send further details of new staff, the new senior leadership and new middle leadership teams at the start of the Autumn Term.

At the start of the academic year, our student body nominated three charities to receive our support. As has become tradition, we chose one local (Lincs and Notts Air Ambulance), one national (Teenage Cancer Trust) and one international (Water Aid) charity to support. Over the course of the year almost £3000 has been raised by our Fundraising and Charity Team through a variety of events, with the money being split between these three very worthy causes. As well as this, we have supported Comic Relief with a staff karaoke event and Jamie's Legacy (a charity set up in memory of a former student) with a staff bench ball tournament.

The house system has been particularly vibrant in its activities throughout this academic year, with competitions as varied as fireworks photography, fantasy football, bingo and pumpkin carving. In total, there have been over 100 different house competitions, and it has been fantastic to see so many students getting involved. Sports Day proved to be a roaring success, seeing students (and staff!) compete to earn points for their respective houses. The winning house will be announced in the end of term house assembly – congratulations to everyone who took part in house competitions across the year for your efforts.
