Reporting – Parents' Evening (Module 2)

- Parents' Evening booking and appointments will be entirely managed through an online platform called **School Cloud**.
- Not everyone will get an appointment with all of their child's teachers, however, *most* teachers will be able to see *most* of their class
- Appointments are in person between 4pm and 6.30pm
- Important opportunity to hear feedback and develop relationships with key Academy staff



Reporting – module grades (Modules 3 and 6)

3 elements – an **attitude to learning** grade and an **attainment** level

- **Attitude to learning** will be assigned **1-4** (with 1 being the highest)
- **Attainment** will be in the form of a **KS3 expected level**
- **Target level**

| KS3 expected level | Definition | Approx GCSE Grade Bands |
|--------------------|---|-------------------------|
| WTS | Students are working at a level towards the expected standards of the year's ambitious curriculum end points | 1 - 2 |
| EXS (F) | Students are working at an expected level , demonstrating foundational knowledge of standards of the year's ambitious curriculum end points | 3 – 4 |
| EXS (E) | Students are working an expected level , demonstrating an established knowledge of standards of the year's ambitious curriculum end points | 5 – 6 |
| GDS | Student working at a level which demonstrates greater depth of standards of the year's ambitious curriculum end points. | 7 - 9 |

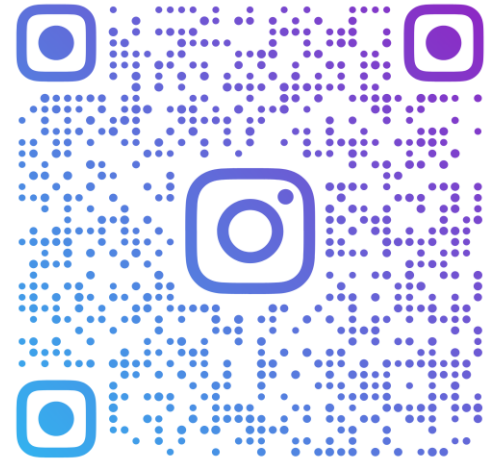
