Secondly, we will explore research that has looked at teachers' beliefs on and practices of multilingualism in England, the UK and internationally. Thirdly, we will explore examples of multilingual activities and practices that stem from work with languages teachers in the UK and internationally. This will be in terms of using learners' entire linguistic repertoires in the languages classroom and in terms of thinking about collaborative ways of working across the languages curricula at your schools.

Language Trends 2024

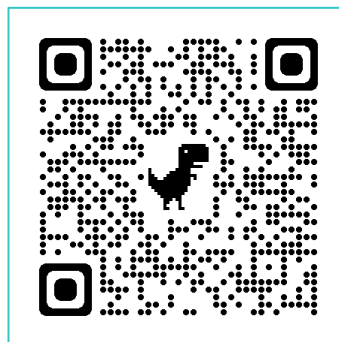
